We have been working diligently in preparing The Fountains of Hope to receive the COVID-19 vaccine for residents and staff. We have submitted all the necessary information for the community and are working closely with the various agencies to finalize the date we will have the vaccine onsite. Presently, we anticipate hosting a vaccine clinic in early January. Once the date is finalized, we will send out another communication with information on when and where the vaccine will be given.

As part of the vaccine rollout, all residents of The Fountains of Hope will have the choice to elect immunizing. In conjunction with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid's recommendation, we strongly encourage all staff to also receive the vaccine. While there are no state or federal mandates to get the vaccine, we ask that residents and staff strongly consider getting vaccinated. We have a variety of ways we want you to make an informed decision. Below are a few:

- Go to the Centers for Disease Control & Prevention at www.cdc.gov and you will find the most recent benefits to receiving the COVID-19 Vaccine. Also, Walgreens and CVS Pharmacy will be participating in administering the vaccine, so both companies have special pages set up on their websites with webinars and resources to explain more about the vaccine.
- We will host two educational sessions with our Bluestone ARNP, Nancy Smith, who can provide an overview of the vaccine and answer questions. The sessions will be held virtually so families and others can participate. The sessions are scheduled for Tuesday, 12/22, and Tuesday, 12/29 at 11:30 ET both days.
