Dear Residents and Family,

We welcome in this new year with hope on the horizon as the COVID vaccine is finally being rolled out across our county and state. We want you to know that we have been and remain in constant contact with the Oakland County Health Department. We have been advised that we can expect the vaccine in the next few weeks but have not been given a firm date yet. Please rest assured that we will let you know as soon as we receive the date from them. The County has been focusing on the most vulnerable populations first, which are the licensed skilled nursing and licensed assisted living communities in our area. Some of these communities may also have independent living and could be included in the initial round of vaccines.

If you do indeed go outside of the community please be cautious and wear your mask properly, covering your mouth and nose, and wash your hands frequently. We will continue to conduct COVID testing at the community for residents and team members.
