- We are only allowing essential visitors at this time. Essential visitors include: RN's, Hospice agencies and hospice families (one family member at a time), Physical and Occupational Therapists.

Prior to entering, Team Members and essential visitors are screened for signs of a fever or other indications of illness, and everyone is required to thoroughly wash or sanitize their hands. We continue to closely monitor all residents and team members for signs and symptoms and immediately follow recommended protocols to isolate or send home someone exhibiting ANY signs of illness. Additionally, residents are encouraged to dine in their apartments. We have postponed all non-medical resident outings and other social events. We strongly encourage Independent Living residents to refrain from leaving the community. We will continue to be vigilant and proactive in navigating this challenging situation.
