Dear Residents and Family,

We appreciate everyone's anxiousness for the COVID vaccine and the many phone calls and emails that we are receiving regarding it. Please know that we are doing everything we can to get this vaccine to you. Quite simply, the demand for the vaccine far outweighs the supply right now. Oakland County is receiving between 1700-2000 vaccines a week even though they have the capacity to administer 20,000 vaccines a week. We are having daily dialogue with them and they have ensured us that we are on the list to receive the vaccine when the supply arrives. The latest vaccine rollout chart released by the state is saying that it may take 2-3 months for them to complete phase 1A.

We are excited to restart small group activities on Monday as the state restrictions on indoor activities have eased. In addition, we have plans in place to reopen the dining rooms on February 1st if the restrictions are lifted at that time. We will continue to conduct COVID testing at the community for residents and team members and do not currently have any positive tests.

We will be in touch as soon as we have more information to share and a firm date communicated to us for the vaccine. We know that this has been a long road for all of you and we are hopeful that we can return to some sense of normalcy sooner than later.
