The City of Brotherly Love Gingerbread House

Want to take a trip to a bigger city? Hop on Interstate 95 and head north to the "City of Brotherly Love"! Philadelphia is the largest city close to Ivy Creek. Take in the sights of Old City and receive a history lesson on William Penn and the Liberty Bell from resident Jody. On your way home, make sure to pick up some french fries from Chickie's and Pete's. They're delicious!

Our City of Brotherly Love Gingerbread House is made with crushed ice cream cones, frosting and Christmas candies to represent the Philadelphia Art Museum. Rocky Balboa stands at the top of the stairs to the museum, the Liberty Bell and the famous LOVE sign, are attached to the roof of the house. We all sang the theme song to "Rocky" while designing this house!

The Conowingo Dam Gingerbread House

Would you like to have bald eagles fly over your head? Grab a camera, a pair of binoculars and take the hour-long drive south on Route 1 to Conowingo Dam. Located in northern Maryland, Conowingo Dam is known for its beautiful scenery and its bald eagles. It is also one of our favorite destinations! Executive Chef Amanda always fills our coolers with a delicious lunch to enjoy while we patiently wait for the eagles to fly by. We all agree it is quite the sight to have the majestic birds fly over your head!

Our Conowingo Dam Gingerbread House is made with blue frosting to represent the water of the dam. There are pretzel goldfish swimming in the water and we used lentils and rice to represent the stones of the dam. On the roof, you will find an eagles' nest made out of pretzels along with Skittles dipped in white frosting to represent eggs. Feathers are woven into the nest and an eagle figurine is perched on the nest. Trees are on the top of the roof to represent the wooded area of the dam. If you're ever in the area, make sure you take a trip to see Conowingo Dam and the eagles!

The Ivy Creek Phillies Gingerbread House

Want to meet someone famous?! How about a whole team of baseball players? Ivy Creek is home of the famous World Series Ivy Creek Phillies! Each Friday the Ivy Creek Phillies defend their bean bag baseball championship against the Ivy Creek Yankees. Both teams consist of talented baseball players ranging in age from the early 70s all the way to 95! It's amazing to watch these sluggers hit home runs and run the bases!

Our Ivy Creek Phillies Gingerbread House is made out of white frosting and candy canes! The Phillies logo is written on each side of the roof and the Philly Phanatic greets you at the front door! The baseball field is done in green frosting, and includes all the bases and even a baseball, glove and bat!

The Coffee & Doughnuts Gingerbread House

Do you like doughnuts? How about homemade doughnuts?! Wake up Saturday mornings to the mouth-watering aroma of homemade doughnuts from the Amish Market.
