

INDOOR VISITS:

These visits must follow the below protocol:

- Each visit must be scheduled in advance by contacting the community at 319-283-3334.
- Each resident/ married couple is allowed one visit per day.
- No more than two family members will be allowed per visit per day.
- Only children who are capable of wearing the required PPE will be allowed to visit.
- Each visit can be up to one hour long.
- These will be no-contact visits. Proper 6ft social distancing will be enforced at all times.
- Each visitor will need to report to the front entrance to be screened by a staff member prior to the visit.
- PPE will be worn at all times while inside the building (mask and gown are required-please bring your own mask).
- All visits will be held in the private dining room.
- No visitors will be allowed to enter a private resident apartment for any reason. No visitors should use the restroom or walk throughout the community.
- No visitors will be allowed without scheduling in advance.
- Rapid Read COVID tests are available when the nurse is present for visitors who wish to be tested. This is not a requirement.

March 3rd: Dr. Seuss' Birthday

Dr. Seuss was born Theodor Seuss Geisel on March 2, 1904, in Springfield, Massachusetts. He drew political cartoons during World War II where he showed his support for President Roosevelt. By the 1950's he was writing children's books under his pen name Dr. Seuss. Some of his well-known titles are "The Cat in the Hat," "How the Grinch Stole Christmas," and "Green Eggs and Ham." He continued writing until his death in 1991.




March 6th: National Dentist Day

CELEBRATE TODAY

March 17th: St Patrick's Day

In 1631 March 17th was declared a feast day by the Catholic Church to honor Saint Patrick, the patron saint of Ireland. In 1948 President Truman attended the St Patrick's Day parade in New York to battle racial prejudice against Irish immigrants. In 1962 Chicago used 60 lbs of



green dye to become the first city to ever successfully dye a river bright green. The COVID-19 pandemic of 2020 caused the world's largest St Patrick's day parade in New York City to be cancelled for the first time in 259 years.

March 29th: National Vietnam War Veterans Day



On this day we commemorate those who fought in the Vietnam War between 1955-1975. Over 2.7 million Americans served during 1973. This day of recognition was founded in 2017 to honor all those who served during the war. Respect and combat support weren't immediately given to those who served after the war ended because of the number of deaths.

March 31st: National Crayon Day

Crayola crayons were introduced in 1903 by Binney & Smith as a safer and cheaper alternative to the art utensils in use at that time. Their famous 8-pack of crayons with the colors: Black, Brown, Orange, Violet, Blue, Green, Red, and Yellow. This color mix, along with their names, remained unchanged for 45

years. Since then, many colors have been added, color names and packaging have changed, and color styles such as neon, metallics, and glitter have emerged. It is estimated the average American will have used 730 crayons by their 10th birthday.
