Stray Dog “Grandfather” Completes Veterinary Program

Meet Fevzi Uyar – a 71-year-old Turkey native with a massive four-legged following!

Known by many as the “Grandfather” to local animals in need, Fevzi has spent the past five years caring for the stray dogs of his community – even going so far as to build them over 80 plywood shelters to help them brave the winter. If that doesn’t tell you how much he loves animals, maybe this will: the former biology teacher also travels more than 90 miles **every two days** to ensure his canine friends have enough food, water, and supplies.

In addition to being their Grandfather, many local dogs also recognize Fevzi as their doctor. Since starting this chapter in his life, Mr. Uyar has also been known to treat dogs in need of immediate care. That’s why he recently enrolled in and graduated from a veterinary medicine program that has equipped him with the ability to vaccinate, treat, and care



for any dog that needs it. And with over 1,000 dogs that now recognize his van, Fevzi is sure to be having his fair share of customers.

To commemorate his compassionate spirit, The Babbitt Family Foundation recognized Mr. Uyar with the Gladiator Award, adding that “We hope Mr. Uyar’s story will inspire you to discover how ‘a single individual can contribute to changing the world and benefitting all humanity’.”
