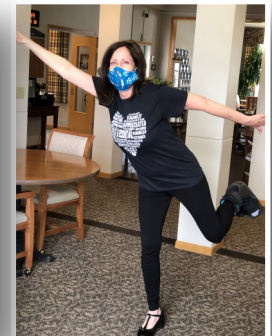
2021 King & Queen of Glenwood Place

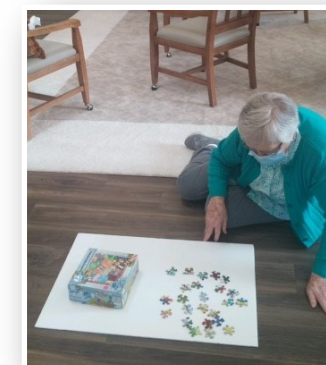
