The Wing Coop

Locations at 569 North, 300 West (Salt Lake City) and 3971 Wasatch Blvd. (Millcreek).



When you focus mostly on one thing you get pretty good at that one thing, and that's the case at Wing Coop. Margarita at Liberty Hill says "they have the best wings and sauces. Vincent and Aaron make this place the best." Their menu primarily consists of wings, boneless wings and chicken tenders, with a chicken sandwich on the menu at their Marmalade location. Smother those wings in one of their more than 20 sauces, including buffalo, barbecue and teriyaki sauces in multiple heat levels, as well as creations like peanut curry, loco lime and raspberry chipolte. Side dishes include onion rings, fried pickles, fried green beans, mac and cheese bites, and Niagara Nachos (waffle fries topped with cheese crumbles and buffalo sauce). Dine in and enjoy a beer with the game on the TV, or pick up an order to go.
