Need Flexibility in Paying Rent?

Cowboy Properties has partnered with Flex to offer you flexibility in how you pay your rent. If it would help you to pay in increments throughout the month instead of paying the full amount on the first of the month, Flex may be right for you. Visit GetFlex.com to sign up.

- · Monthly subscription fee is \$19.99.
- · You have until the 3rd of the month to sign up to have your rent paid for that month, but will still be charged any late fees that occur before that day.
- Rent gets paid to Flex in two equal installments.
- · You must be paying your rent through RentCafe to use the service.
- · Qualifying requirements include linking your bank account through the app and passing a soft credit check (score of 550 or higher). You must be current on your rent payments.
- You must pay the previous month's rent in full before next month's will be covered.
