When COVID-19 first struck, what were once everyday jobs quickly became known as "essential businesses." Among this unique and necessary workforce were truck drivers – round-the-clock workers tasked with delivering anything and everything to a population sheltering from a global pandemic. Fortunately, their work hasn't gone unappreciated.

Beverly Perrin, an Ontario senior with no shortage of love to give, spent the early days of quarantine with her husband, Dick, creating 75 to 100 "thank-you" cards for truck drivers, which the pair would then deliver to a nearby truck-stop once every three to four weeks. Truck drivers would often find themselves surprised when they would find Beverly's personalized message of gratitude:
