### Mark of the Beastro

Playing off the street address and local <u>famous</u> <u>gravestone</u> with the same number, Mark of the Beastro is a devilishly-themed vegan diner. Our resident says they have "amazing diner food!" While many vegan restaurants are known for their health food, the Beastro serve up comfort foods of burgers (no-beef patties),

vegan fried chicken sandwiches, fried soy wings and 'mockzarella' sticks made of fried palm hearts. Breakfast is served all day and includes chick'n and



waffles, garbage hash and a tofu benedict. If you'd still like a salad, try the giant The Beast house fried chicken cobb salad. They partner with The Beehive next door for live concerts and entertainment. Mark of the Beastro is offering takeout only at this time.
