Doves are often referred to as "A Pigeon with a good PR agent". Pigeons and Doves belong to the same family, Columbidae, and have many similar features. Doves are generally slightly smaller than Pigeons but have longer tails. Pigeons are the only birds in the world that do not need to lift their head to swallow water. After finding a mate, males begin selecting a nest site. Nest construction takes over ten hours and covers a span of three to four days. Female mourning doves generally lay two small, white eggs in an open nest. Both sexes incubate, the male from morning to afternoon, and the female the rest of the day and at night. Mourning doves are devoted parents; nests are very rarely left unattended by the adults.

The young leave the nest about 15 days after hatching but remain nearby until they are more accomplished at flying, usually at about 30 days old.
