Dear residents, team members, and families:

Today marks an exciting day in our community as we continue moving closer and closer to our pre-pandemic lifestyle. Starting Monday, May 24, we are discontinuing our mask requirements in most areas of campus for all fully vaccinated people! The thought of seeing people's entire smiling faces fills me with joy, and I hope it does the same for you.

We are confident about this decision based on new guidance from the CDC and because we have successfully followed COVID-19 precautions by working together as a community to reduce our risks. As we have done all along, we will continue to observe precautions to keep everyone safe. Please familiarize yourself with the following policies:

- All unvaccinated residents, team members, visitors, and vendors are required to wear a mask unless in their private home or when actively eating/drinking.
- All residents, team members, visitors, and vendors will continue to be screened at the front entrance each time they arrive on campus. This is due to state regulations requiring a formal COVID-19 screening process for all licensed areas.
- Fully vaccinated residents, visitors, and vendors will be allowed to enjoy all campus areas mask-free.
- Fully vaccinated team members may also be mask-free unless working in licensed areas of campus. Regardless of vaccination status or length of stay, all team members will need to wear masks in the licensed areas.
- Proof of vaccination must be shown during screening in order for visitors and vendors to go mask-free.
- For peace of mind, fully vaccinated team members will receive a green ribbon that indicates their vaccination status, so you can be assured of your and their safety.
- Daily health screenings for assisted living and memory care residents will be discontinued.
- The use of face shields for unvaccinated team members will be discontinued unless needed due to specific infection control or outbreak need. However, unvaccinated team members are still required to wear a face mask in all areas of the community.
- Children are once again welcomed as visitors.
 - Fully vaccinated children do not need to wear masks.
 - Unvaccinated children over the age of 2 are required to wear masks.
- This plan is subject to change based on necessity, including changes in regulations, health risks, or outbreak status.



As we embark on this exciting new chapter, I want to thank each of you for remaining resilient members of our community. We learned so much over the past year, and I am deeply grateful for all of your efforts. So now, let's celebrate with one another as we resume Touchmark's Full Life!
