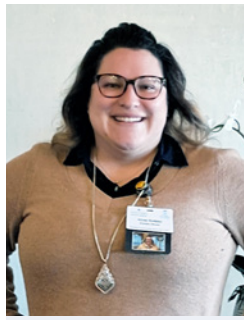

CARDIO-DRUMMING

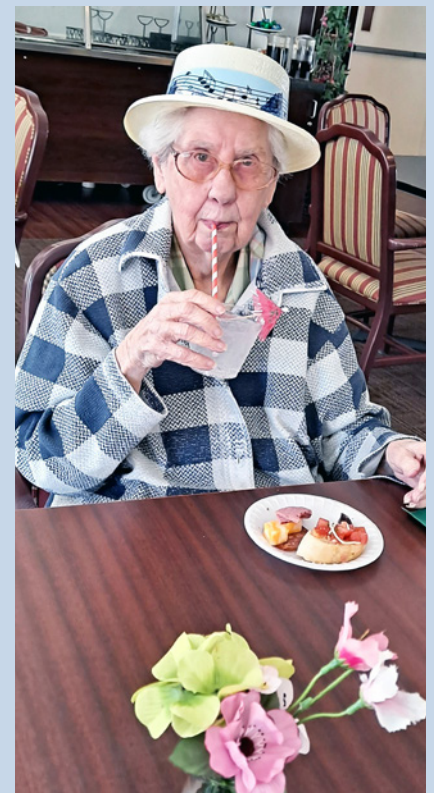
