Our theme dinner took us to France where we learned about the French culture, traditions and we enjoyed a delicious dinner too!

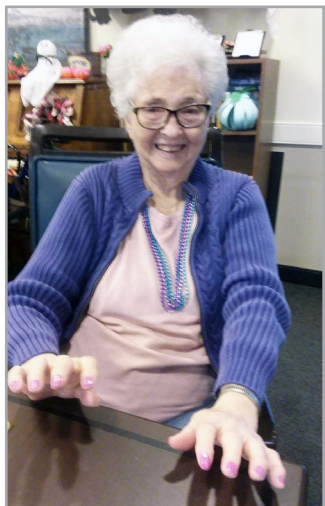
Taste of Town
