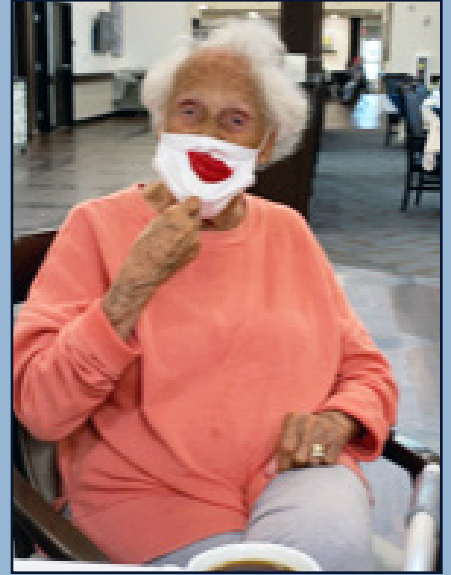
ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS

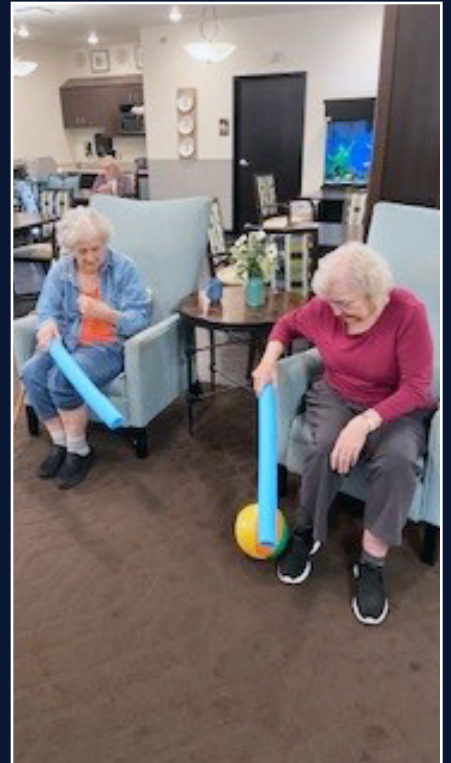
