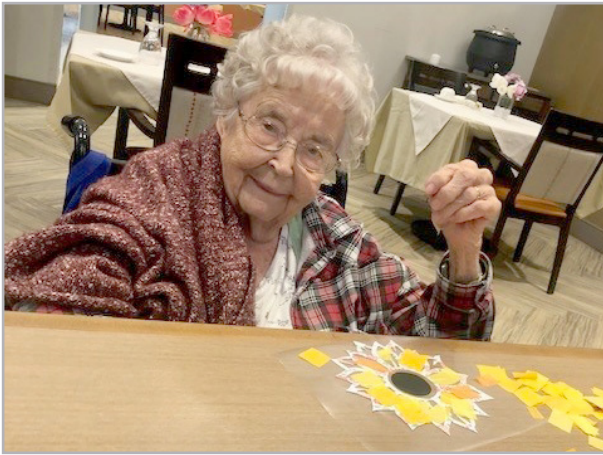


# HAPPY HOUR

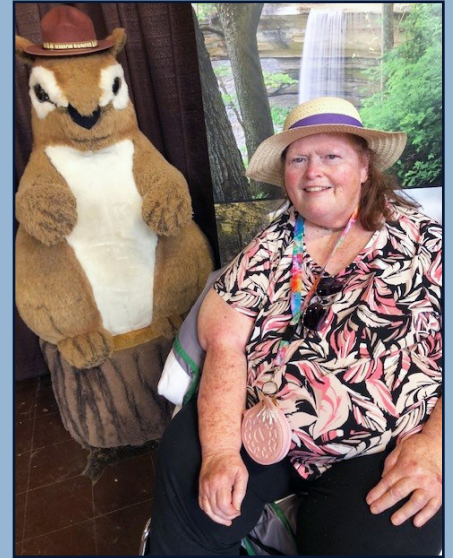
