surfaces and tells us where further disinfection efforts are needed.

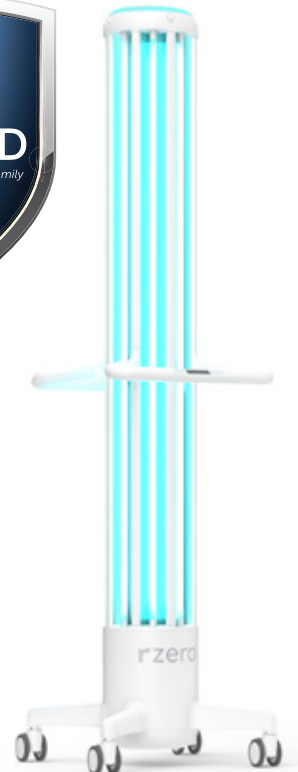

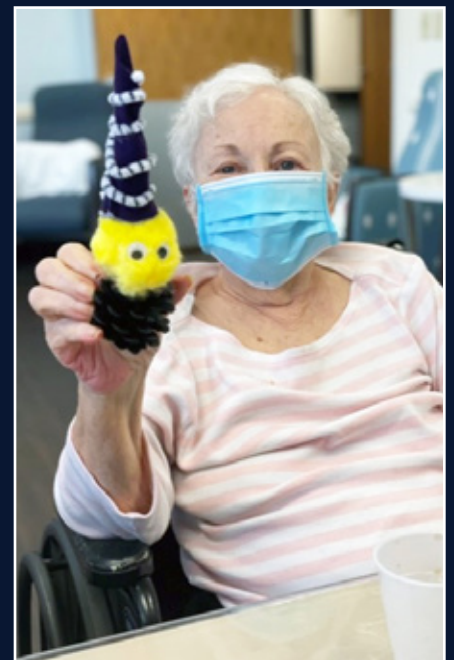
