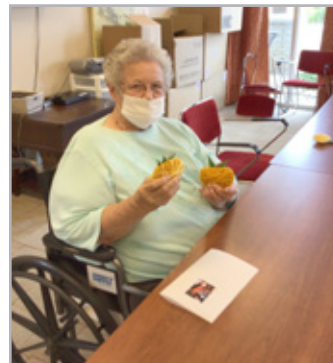
Volunteer News
