Have a wonderful holiday and a Happy New Year!

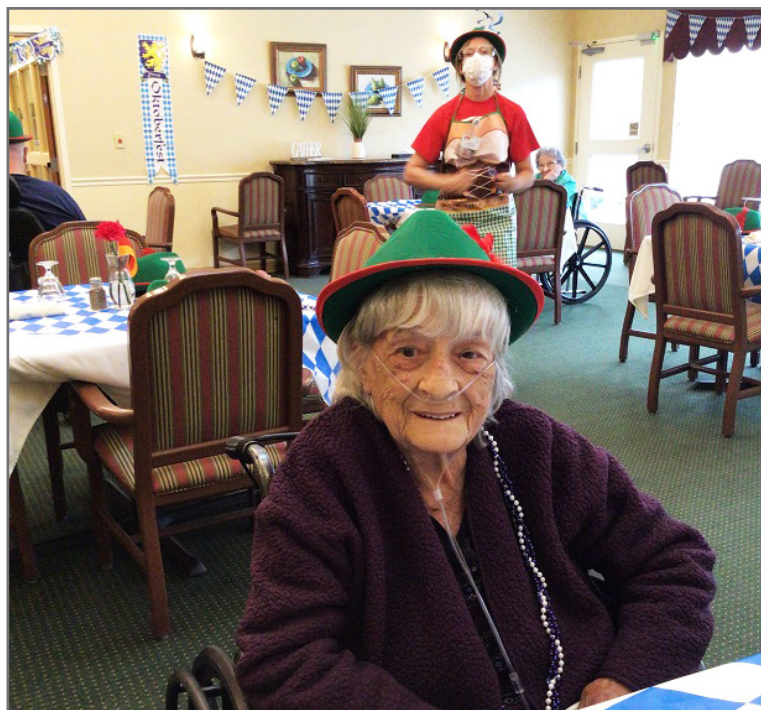
