### Things We Loved from 2020


It's an understatement to say that 2020 was a pretty wild year. Here are a few memorable things that have come out of it all.

Utahns age 75 or older will be the first to receive the COVID-19 vaccine in the next phase of the state's rollout, the Utah Department of Health announced on Monday. Click here for an updated anticipated timeline for vaccine distribution.
