Covid-19 Update

The State of Utah had a report on how wearing a mask can help the economy.

The University of Utah launched a crowdfunding campaign <u>dedicated to funding research on</u> COVID-19 long-hauler symptoms.

The CDC is set to shorten the recommended length of quarantine after exposure to someone who is positive for Covid-19 to 10 days, or seven days if they receive a negative test.

CDC panel says <u>health workers and nursing</u> <u>homes will get the Covid vaccine first</u>.
