Hidden Gems: Mural Art

Located on busy streets and hidden behind buildings, Salt Lake City has several extraordinary murals located around the city and waiting for you to find. Visit Salt Lake has a roundup of several of those murals, including 'The Book Wall' pictured below, which was commissioned by Sam Weller's Books for their 75th anniversary in 2004.



The Discovery Gateway Children's Museum has a <u>Silly Mural Walk</u>, designed to get kids talking about and noticing details in art. The walk is <u>entirely outside</u> and features seven pieces of art.

Zions Bank commissioned the <u>Utah Women 2020 Mural</u> earlier this year, featuring over 250 women from Utah's past and present. One of the artists is <u>Jann Haworth</u>, a Salt Lake City artist most famous as the <u>co-creator of The Beatles' Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band album cover.</u>
