Make All Your Rooms Look Good

Check out these tips to help decorate your home!

Clear Furniture

Items made of acrylic, lucite or glass can help make your home look bigger by disappearing into the background. Try this <u>three-piece</u> <u>nesting</u> option for a side table or stack them on top of each other to make a bookshelf. This <u>waterfall table</u> is a fun option for a living room coffee table. Create a unique display box with this <u>clear trunk</u>.

Design Up

Make your walls work better for you! Hooks on the wall can help hang everything from <u>coats</u> to <u>extra chairs</u> to <u>pots and pans</u>. Lean a <u>ladder</u> against the wall to hang extra blankets. Instead of a rack in the bathroom that holds one towel, put them all in one place with this <u>towel ladder</u>. Grow herbs, succulents and flowers in this <u>wallmounted planter</u>. A <u>small multi-tiered shelf</u> by the front door or in your entryway closet can help contain shoes, purses, hats and gloves. A <u>ladder desk</u> combines a bookshelf and desk and is great for small and narrow workspaces.

Huge Artwork

It may seem counterintuitive to use a big piece of artwork in a small room, but one large piece of artwork instead of many smaller pieces adds a focal point to the room and can give it a minimalist feel. Your choice of artwork says a lot about your style and taste. If you're on a budget, try a <u>tapestry</u>.
