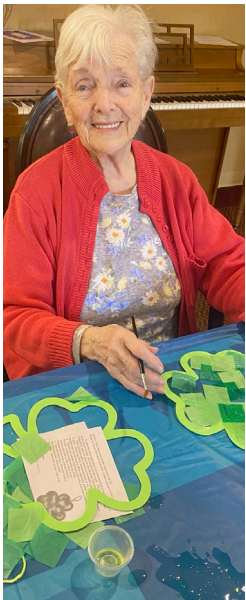
THE STORM CHASER

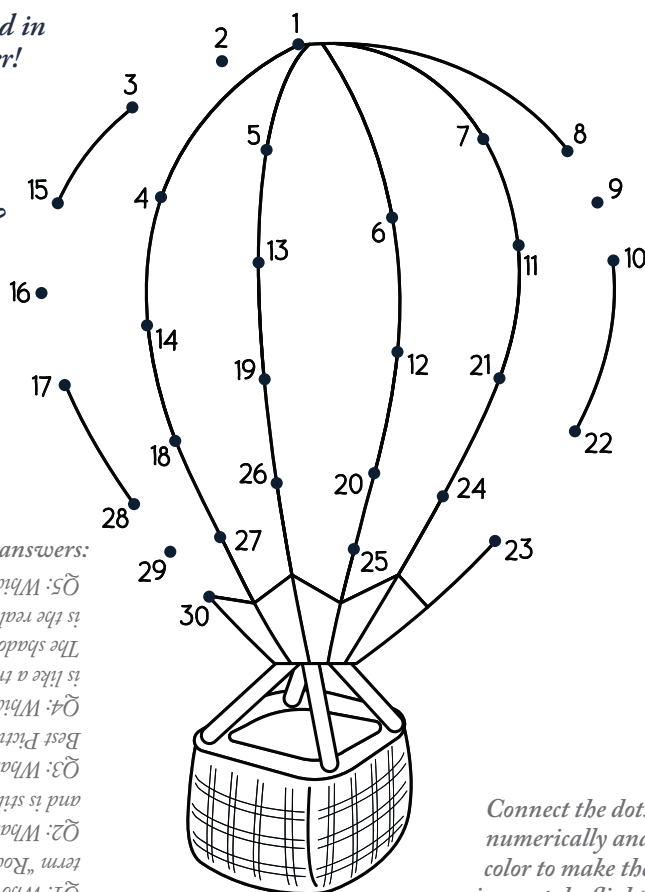
