

Another Rehab Therapy Success Story

We recently rehabilitated an 84-year-old female who was hospitalized after sustaining a fall. The fall resulted in a displaced comminuted left humerus fracture, and she underwent surgery for a reverse total shoulder replacement. She was also found to be Covid positive.

Interestingly, studies have found that symptoms such as falls observed in older adults can be associated with Covid-19 infection.

This patient lives in an apartment independently. She was driving and completing all mobility independently. She was

babysitting her 4 1/2-year-old granddaughter every day and taking her to school. She was completing all her own cooking, cleaning, and grocery shopping.

She was motivated to get back to taking care of her granddaughter, she worked hard in therapy to regain her strength and independence. Her left arm was in a sling, so she had to re-learn how to dress herself, prepare meals, transport items, and walk with a cane. She was able to return home alone with supportive home health services and intermittent assistance from her daughter.

Visitation Guidelines:

Our staff will assist you upon entry. Everyone is required to wear a mask (provided) and complete our covid-19 screening form for visitors.

Everyone is welcome to visit with appropriate PPE and health screening at the door!
