



Another Rehab Therapy Success Story

An 87 year-old female was recently admitted to our facility for rehab. She was found on the bathroom floor by her son after a fall. Upon admission, she had difficulty standing and could not walk. She was very weak and had significant dizziness, which slowly improved during her stay. She initially required help with all of her activities of daily living and required assist of 2 caregivers to transfer. She was able to start using a walker, but required slow, 2+ minutes to transitions from lying to sitting, and sitting to standing. She was very motivated to participate in therapy, and after 3 weeks, she was able to return home with her

family. She was able to ambulate with a walker, bathe and dress herself and retrieve meals that were prepared by her family.
