Celebrating Our Flag

Flag Day is a celebration of the symbol that unified our country during the Revolutionary War. When the fighting first broke out in 1775, each colony was still fighting under their own separate and unique flags. In June of 1775, after the second Continental Congress, the idea of an American flag to unite the colonies was proposed.

The first version of the American Flag was called

the "Continental Colors."
However, it didn't take
George Washington
long to realize that the
flag was too similar to
the British Union Jack
to inspire American
soldiers. Plans for a
new flag were soon
put into motion, until

finally, on June 14th, 1777, the Continental Congress approved the first official design for the American flag.

Despite its storied history, Flag Day was not an official holiday until over 100 years later, when President Woodrow Wilson declared June 14th, 1916, the first Flag Day in American History.


