This month we promote awareness about how to recognize the signs of a stroke. National Stroke Awareness Month is a campaign put on by the National Stroke Association.

It is very important to know the signs for a stroke as early detection makes treatment far easier and damage is less likely to be permanent. To identify a stroke remember the acronym FAST

F - Face Drooping. Does one side of the face droop or is it numb?

A - Arm Weakness. Is one arm weak or numb?

S - Speech. Is speech slurred?

T - Time to Call 9-1-1. If someone shows any of these symptoms, even if the symptoms go away, call 9--1 and get to a hospital immediately.
