

Career path within assisted living (CBRF)



RA

Resident Assistant

An essential caregiving position in CBRFs, RAs offer care & companionship to residents and help with hygiene, dressing, eating, bathing, transfers, activities & more.

MA

Medication Assistant

In assisted livings, Resident Assistants often quickly become Medication Assistants through certification so they can pass medications to residents.

CNA

Certified Nursing Assistant

CNAs are similar to RAs, but are certified by the state and can assist with a higher level of care for residents like taking vital signs, recording health conditions and working with nursing staff.

CBRF Admin

CBRF Administrator

Many experienced CNAs become assisted living home administrators. Additional courses are required for this highly responsible management position that offers excellent job growth.

LPN

Licensed Practical Nurse

In other applications, like a nursing home, hospital or home health, LPNs oversee all aspects of patient care through the supervision of CNAs and also provide nursing care to residents.

RN

Registered Nurse

Directs the care of residents and patients in nursing homes, hospitals and home health by administering medications, performing treatments, assessing residents' & patients' conditions, and communicates with physicians.

NCM

Nurse Case Manager

Manages the care of residents & patients - usually in nursing homes, hospitals - from admission to discharge, and also supervises nursing staff. RNs often choose an area of specialized interest.

DON

Director of Nursing

Oversees, develops and directs the nursing department, administers resident/patient care, ensures regulatory compliance and develops health-care partnerships within the local community.
