# Residents of the Month: Charlotte L.

Charlotte V. J. was born on July 3rd, 1923, to her proud parents Ben and Cora Johnson of Stitzer Wisconsin. Charlotte was later joined by a sister, Bernice and two brothers Kenneth and Douglas. The family lived above Platt Cheese Factory which Ben managed, it was a family effort with Cora and all of the children working in the factory.

They enjoyed all the outdoor fun, playing games, fishing and swimming as they lived near the Platt River. Saturday nights would include trips into town to go to the movies and visit with friends. Charlotte attended Kemper school and then Fennimore High School. Charlotte worked at Telephone Central in Stetzer while in high school. Her first night alone at the switchboard became very scary as there was a dangerous storm in the area causing a farm fire. Anything that could go wrong did go wrong and she did everything to bring together volunteer firefighters and rescue workers.

Charlotte often went to Fennimore dances where she met Morris Loy and attended the senior prom with him. They married on December 31st, 1941 and farmed for 15 years in the area Charlotte and Morris have

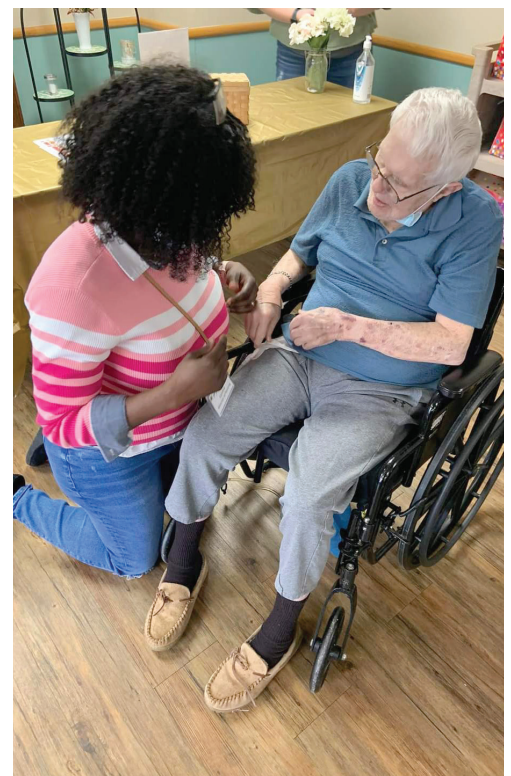
three children Nancy, Linda and Dennis. Because of his asthma Morris left farming to haul bulk milk which he did for 17 years at that time they moved to the East Side of Madison. Charlotte worked for stockbrokers Thomas and McKinnon and Morris later became a janitor for the Madison school system. Charlotte later worked for the Madison City Engineer office. Retiring in 1984 they spent ten years living in Wisconsin Rapids on lake camisole and they spent their winter months in Mesa, AZ where Charlotte learned to line dance. She would later join Carol's country kickers align dancing group who have entertained at angle side in the past Charlotte came up with the name for the group and danced with them for 20 years.

After living in Wisconsin Rapids Charlotte and Morris built a home and moved to Mount Horeb in 2005. Morris was eventually a resident at Ingleside for four and a half years and passed away in 2010. Charlotte has numerous grandchildren and great grandchildren she even has a great great granddaughter (Lennox). She is very honored to have a wonderful family.



Charlotte has been at Ingleside for over 8 years now. She says they are all good to me. Here at Ingleside I look forward to horticulture therapy, crafts and treat carts, my favorite is a Culver's lunch in as I went to school with a Culver. I am very comfortable here and have made many friends. I will be celebrating my 99th birthday this July 3rd! I've lived a good life and I'm very proud of my family.
