

### A NOTE FROM NIT

Preparing the home for a person who has had a stroke, a surgery, or any other medical episode is essential to creating a risk-free environment that permits ease of movement and activities, and makes life easier for the resident, the family, and the caregiver. Depending on the individual's disabilities, some may be temporary modifications, while others are permanent. There are tricks and tips that each family will discover while going through the process or may be suggested by their healthcare professionals. Scheduling a home visit with an Occupational Therapist can be valuable. This highly trained professional will evaluate the home, familiarize themselves with the family and the resident's daily activities and routines, and go over the new challenges that will arise from medical episodes. The Occupational Therapist will make recommendations for modifications to provide a safe environment for the resident and family, suggest any assistive devices, and offer tips on accomplishing everyday tasks and activities.

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

#### **SEAS THE DAY**


