Celebrating Statehood! Wishing you all a happy Pioneer Day! Pioneer Day celebrates the entry of the first group of pioneers into the Salt Lake Valley on July 24, 1847. Due to July 24 falling on Sunday, many events will be held on Saturday, July 23, or Monday, July 25.

# Days of '47 Parade

Saturday, July 23, 9:00 AM Salt Lake City

The parade begins at Temple Square (South Temple and State Street), travels down 200 East and ends at Liberty Park (600 E 900 S). Set up to see it or watch live on KSL 5. The parade features colorful floats, bands, horses, clowns and other entries.

# Days of '47 Rodeo

Thursday, July 21 - Monday, July 25 (Sunday off) Utah State Fairpark (155 E 1000 W). SLC Featuring bareback riding, saddle bronc riding, bull riding, barrel racing, team roping, steer wrestling, tie-down roping, and women's breakaway roping. Gates to the Fairpark open at 4:30 PM each day for carnival rides, food trucks, vendors and exhibits and no ticket is required for Fairpark entry.

### **Laser Light Nights**

Saturday, July 23, 8:00 - 10:00 PM Liberty Park (600 E 900 S), Salt Lake City The show will begin after dark (about 9:45 PM) and last 15-20 minutes.

# Pie and Beer Day

Sunday, July 24, 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM The Gateway (400 W 200 S), Salt Lake City This alternative celebration features 24 breweries and 24 bakeries with over 9000 slices of pie. Live performances will be held on The Plaza Stage. Pie passes will be sold at the door and will include five beer and pie pairings for \$40.

# Ogden Pioneer Days Grande Parade

The parade begins on 31st Street, continues north on Washington Boulevard and ends on 20th Street. Represented are marching bands, service organizations, student body representatives from Ogden-area schools, floats, horse drawn carriages, antique automobiles, and youth dance groups.
