#### Community Stewardship

We love our outdoors, and several organizations offer opportunities to assist with cleanup, preservation and education.

#### Jordan River Commission

Jordan River Parkway

The second Saturday of every month the Commission meets in a different spot to do trail head cleanups, storm drain cleaning and maintenance and restoration work. They also partner with the Hogle Zoo's Conservation Action Program once a month to plant trees, remove invasive weeds and clean up trash. Contact them to receive a trash bag and gloves to pick up trash on your own or learn how your group can volunteer together.

#### Gilgal Sculpture Garden Gardener
