Are you a Veteran or Surviving Spouse?

The Program

The VA Pension program can often provide the financial assistance necessary for Veterans and their un-remarried surviving spouses to meet the costs of care in a senior living community. The current maximum monthly VA Pension benefits are \$2169.00 for a married veteran, \$1830.00 for a single veteran, and \$1176.00 for a surviving spouse.

Basic Eligibility Requirements

- Veterans must generally have served at least 90-days of active duty military service other than in the National Guard or Reserves..
- There are limitations on income and net worth. Your home, car, and personal possessions are exempt assets.
- In general, a claimant must have allowable medical expenses to off-set some or all of their household income. Living in a Seasons community is usually a fully deductible expense.
- To add the special aid and attendance benefit there must be a medical diagnosis indicating the need for supervision or direct assistance with your normal daily activities such as:
 - Bathing or Showering
 - Dressing
 - Personal Hygiene
 - Managing Medications
 - Getting out of bed
 - Proper Nutrition & Hydration
