In order to process a payment, you will need to have your account number. Visa, Mastercard, Discover Card and electronic checks will be accepted. TESTING FOR QUALITY

- At the Town Center Drive Pump Station, originally built in the mid-1960's, obsolete equipment was replaced and the overall facility was upgraded.
- Improvements included replacing aged instrumentation panels, the motor control center, exhaust fans and updating the mechanics throughout.
- These improvements increase overall efficiency, and help to ensure the system will be safe and reliable for years to come.






- The Sod Run and Joppatowne Wastewater Treatment plants exceed environmental goals set by the state.

Every drop of water that comes through your tap has been thoroughly tested. Over 229,000 tests are conducted annually to ensure the water you drink exceeds regulatory quality standards.

Quality standards for testing are outlined in the Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974. The SDWA includes a provision requiring annual quality reporting to our customers. Harford County Water & Sewer has never been out of compliance on any measure.
