The Wild West Comes to Minnesota: The James-Younger Gang Rides into Northfield

On September 7th, 1876, the Wild West came to Northfield, Minnesota. The Younger Gang had made a name for themselves by robbing banks all throughout Missouri, but after 10 years of the same, they decided it was time for a change.

The three Younger brothers, as well as two other outlaws, made their way to Northfield, Minnesota. (Though it was never fully proven, it is largely believed that Frank and Jesse James also rode with the Younger Gang and participated in the attempted robbery that followed.)

The outlaws rode into town at 2:00 PM, and soon split into three groups—One group was to enter the bank, one was to guard the entrance to prevent any bystanders or law enforcement from entering during the robbery, and one group waited in Mill Square to guard the gang's escape route.

They didn't, however, count on the townsfolk of Northfield to be as brave—or as nosy—as they turned out to be. One gentleman by the name of J.S. Allen followed the strangers into the First National Bank, only to immediately be held at gunpoint. He reportedly broke free and alerted the town, shouting, "Get your guns, boys! They're robbing the bank!"

With their cover blown, things only got worse for the bandits. The townsfolk quickly descended upon them, killing two gang members, and driving the rest out of town! They left behind \$15,000 dollars in the vault, and a story that's lasted hundreds of years.


Classic Car Talk
