In addition to a free flight, these trips include deluxe tour bus service, meals, snacks, t-shirts, and several other amenities. Honor Flight Network also provides trained, volunteer guardians to accompany veterans through the entire trip if the veteran is without one.

able to speak with several other
WWII service members from the
area and take an Honor Flight
