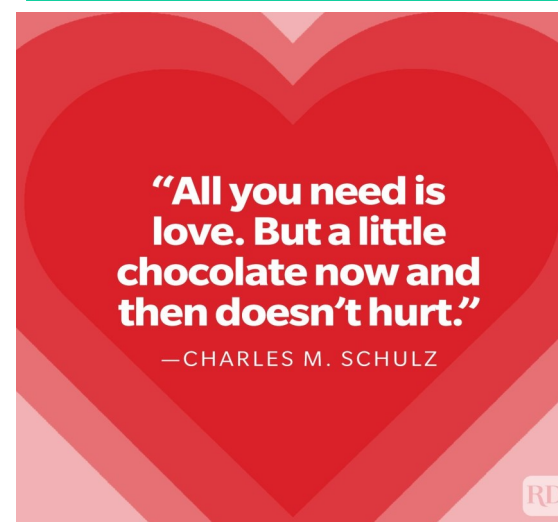

As many of you are aware already, we have made some changes recently in our Food Service Department.
