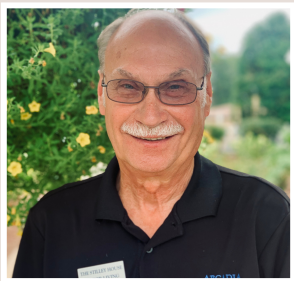


### **Adam Ketelsen, Director of Culinary Services**
