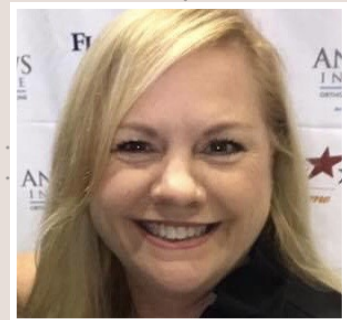


Carol Ettelson, Executive Director

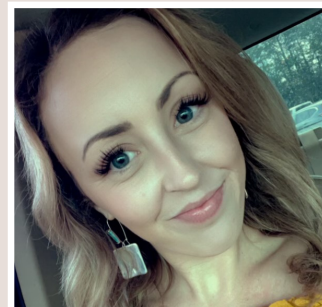


Nerrissa Lynn Dunn, Business Office Director
