IN THE GOOD OL' DAYS OF JUNE

IN JUNE 1923, THE AVERAGE ANNUAL INCOME WAS \$3,227. THE AVERAGE TAXPAYER PAID \$86.21 AT A RATE OF 2.67% OF THEIR INCOME. THE AVERAGE COST OF A NEW HOUSE WAS \$6,296, OR ABOUT \$80,000 IN TODAY'S DOLLARS. A LOAF OF BREAD WAS 12¢, A GALLON OF MILK WAS 60¢, BUTTER WAS 70¢ A POUND, STEAK WAS 40¢ A POUND, AND A DOZEN EGGS WERE 68¢. STAMPS WERE 2¢ EACH. A CARCOST \$525, AND GAS WAS 14¢ PER GALLON.
