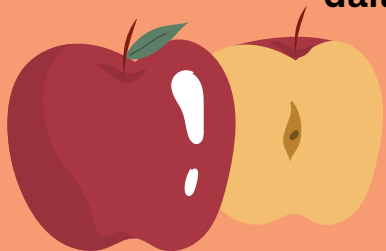


Director's Corner
