"The love we give away is the only love we keep." A quote from Elbert Hubbard. The same person to whom we attribute the phrase, "When life gives you lemons, make lemonade".

Near the end of his life, he had written about the sinking of the Titanic and the bravery of passenger Ida Straus. When the lifeboats were being filled with women and children, she had refused and instead chose to remain with her husband. Hubbard wrote about the couple saying that, "In life they were never separated and in death they are not divided."

Incredibly, it was only three years later that Elbert Hubbard and his wife also found themselves on a sinking ship, the Lusitania, after being torpedoed by a German U-boat. A witness described that they walked the flooding deck, unbothered, armin-arm. Someone asked what they were going to do, and Mrs. Hubbard smiled and replied that there didn't seem to be anything to do. Elbert then guided them both into a cabin and closed the door behind them, so they wouldn't be separated when the water came.

The love we give away is the only love we keep. It is never selfish. From the day we arrive until the day we go, the only love that remains is the comfort, the tenderness, and the peace that we give to someone else. I hope that you are blessed with this enduring kind of love.
