

DOOR LOCKS

If a resident's bathroom door is locked and he/she is unable to open it, there is a key on any Nurses key ring that will open all bathroom doors.

The doors to medication cupboards and medication storage rooms will be kept closed and locked whenever a Nurse is not in attendance. Each Nurse on duty will have a key to these areas in the Nursing Station to which she is assigned.

All storage areas will be kept locked at all times.

Any other area where there are items that are potentially harmful to residents, such as cleaning supplies, health and beauty aids, hair care products, etc. shall be kept locked at all times.

All the outside doors to the Nursing Home will be kept locked after dark.

All offices and rooms in the office hall will be kept locked after office hours.
