SHAVING THE RESIDENT

PURPOSE:

To remove facial hair and improve the resident's appearance and morale.

EQUIPMENT:

- 1. Disposable razor or resident's own electric razor.
- 2. Towel.
- 3. Washcloth.
- 4. Soap or shaving cream.
- 5. Tissues.
- 6. After shave lotion if available.
- 7. Basin half-filled with hot water.

PROCEDURE:

DISPOSABLE SAFETY RAZOR:

- 1. Assist the resident to a comfortable sitting position unless contraindicated and drape.
- 2. Fill basin half-full of hot water.
- 3. Apply warm washcloth to beard to soften.
- 4. Apply shaving cream or soap to beard.
- 5. Encourage resident to participate in care as much as possible. Give simple instructions and be patient.
- 6. Pull skin taut in the opposite direction of the razor stroke. Use firm, gentle strokes and shave against the direction of hair growth.
- 7. Rinse razor frequently; remove hair with tissue.
- 8. Rinse the resident's face, dry and apply after-shave lotion.
- 9. Clean and return equipment to proper storage area.
- 10. Position resident comfortably with call light within reach.

ELECTRIC RAZOR:

- 1. Follow step #1 above.
- 2. Wash and dry resident's face well.
- 3. Encourage resident to participate in care as much as possible. Give simple instructions and be patient.
- 4. Shave by pulling skin taut in opposite direction of the razor stroke. Use firm, gentle strokes and shave against the direction of hair growth.
- 5. Wash and dry resident's face well; apply after shave lotion.
- 6. Disassemble razor and rinse parts touching skin; rinse with alcohol. Do not wet electrical portion of razor.
- 7. Clean and return equipment to proper storage area.
- 8. Position resident comfortably with call light within reach.
