TURNING ROUNDS

PURPOSE:

- 1. To cleanse, refresh and reposition bedfast and wheelchair-bound residents on a regular basis.
- 2. To stimulate circulation.
- 3. To inspect resident's body.

EQUIPMENT:

- 1. Cleansing solution.
- 2. Linen as necessary.
- 3. Washcloth and towel.
- 4. Plastic bag.
- 5. Soiled linen container.
- 6. Moisture barrier.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Gather equipment and bring to bedside.
- 2. Screen resident for privacy.
- 3. Explain procedure to resident.
- 4. Take resident to bathroom or place on bedpan as outline on plan of care.
- 5. If incontinent, remove soiled linen and place in soiled linen container or change disposable briefs as necessary.
- 6. Wash perineal area with cleansing solution, dry thoroughly. Apply moisture barrier.
- 7. Inspect skin.
- 8. Replace any soiled linen with clean linen and re-position the resident.
- 9. Leave resident in comfortable position with call light in reach.

Turning rounds are done every 2 hours unless otherwise noted on plan of care

REPORT:

- 1. Report any skin problems.
- 2. Report any resident complaints.
