

Miami Beach's largest affordable housing project in 45 years breaks ground

The Housing Authority of the City of Miami Beach and Atlantic Pacific Cos. broke ground on the largest affordable housing project in the city in 45 years.

At a time when Miami Beach has become one of the most expensive cities to live in Florida, the new Vista Breeze will offer apartments for seniors making up to 80% of area median income. The median household income in Miami-Dade County is \$74,700, according to HUD.

Located near the Normandy Shores Golf Club, Vista Shores is under development on the 30,600-square-foot site at 280 and 300 S. Shore Drive. It will feature 119 studio apartments.

Miami-based Atlantic Pacific is self-performing as general contractor. Fort Lauderdale-based Brooks + Scarpa is the architect. It should be completed in late spring 2025.

Vista Breeze was founded by \$9 million from the Florida Housing Finance Corp., a \$1 million loan from the city, an \$11.87 million loan from Citi Community Capital, a \$5.95 million surtax loan from Miami-Dade County, and bonds issued by the Miami-Dade County Housing Finance Authority.

It typically takes multiple sources of funding and government assistance to make affordable housing projects financially viable. The site is on a land lease from the Housing Authority.
