I am sure you will learn to appreciate and respect her wisdom, professionalism and vast experience in senior living.

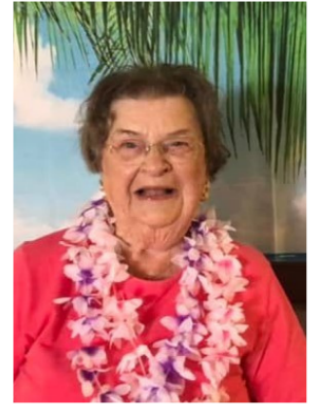
